Instructions

If you're 16 or older you must have a permit. Younger archers do not need permits but must have adult supervision. To determine if a supervising adult needs a permit, call Visitor Services at 630-933-7248. You can apply for a permit one of four ways:

- Visit dupageforest.org 24/7 and click "Registration & Permits" and "Purchase Permits."
- Bring this completed form to Visitor Services at 35580 Naperville Road in Wheaton Monday – Friday 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.
- Fax this completed form to 630-933-7217. (Add five to seven business days for processing.)
- Mail this completed form to Forest Preserve District of DuPage County, 35580 Naperville Road, Wheaton, IL 60189. (Add five to seven business days for processing.)

Blackwell	Beginner (open daily March 1 – Nov. 30; closed remainder of year)	Eight lanes up to 25 yards; safety netting on three sides
	Advanced (open year-round)	11 lanes up to 90 meters
	Interactive (open daily March 1 – Nov. 30; closed remainder of year)	Nine lanes up to 60 yards

Rules and Regulations and Waiver

Please read this information carefully. It includes releases of liability and waiver of legal rights and deprives you of the ability to sue certain parties. By checking the boxes and providing your name and the date, you acknowledge you've read and understood all of the text.

Rules and Regulations

For everyone's safety and enjoyment, you must follow these rules and regulations, which the Forest Preserve District may change at any time.

- If you're 16 or older you must carry and display a permit when using the range and present it to a Forest Preserve District agent for inspection if asked. Younger archers do not need permits but must have adult supervision. To determine if a supervising adult needs a permit, call Visitor Services at 630-933-7248.
- Ranges are for archery use only, and use is first-come, first-served unless someone obtains exclusive use from the Forest Preserve District via written request.
- Never use crossbows, broadhead points, or aerial targets or devices. (You can only use a crossbow if you qualify under the Americans with Disability Act and include a copy of your disability ID card with your permit application.)
- Always walk in the archery range. Never run.
- Do not move to the shooting line until the range is clear or someone gives the proper whistle command.
- Keep your arrows in a quiver until you're ready to shoot.
- Only point arrows at the ground or your target.
- Shoot only at your target. At the interactive range, shoot only at the target that's the same color as the zone you're shooting in (green, yellow or red).
- Do not advance to the target until someone gives the all-clear or the proper whistle command. Additionally, at the interactive range, do not shoot if a flag is deployed on any of the bow racks. The flag's a signal someone is retrieving arrows.

By checking the box below I agree to abide by these rules and regulations as well as all Forest Preserve District ordinances and administrative orders and state statutes. I understand that the Forest Preserve District may fine me or revoke my permit without refunding my permit fee if I supply false information on this application or fail to comply with any rules, regulations, ordinances, orders or statutes.
